While employed at NFL Films, I was able to "reach" out to those former players in financial and medical need. From my first event when I emceed the Deacon Jones Golf Charity Fund raising event in 1997 to my most recent function"; my Celebrity Golf Tournament in Rhode Island, I have had the good fortune of "meeting" some of the finest associated with the game of Professional Football.

Many of the game's best have come upon "troubled" times: Hall of Fame players' John Mackey from the Baltimore Colts, Willie Wood from the Green Bay Packers and Pete Pihos from the Philadelphia Eagles and other former NFL Player suffer from Dementia. Although "retirees" **"earned" a pension**, it is no where enough to live on.
